

#### THE DIRECTOR'S NOTE

I have a love/hate relationship with suspense and horror films. I can't avert my eyes or plug my ears completely, but I'll try my hardest to get almost to that point. When I was a kid, I would run out of the

room for jump scares, but still be just close enough that I could hear and still "experience" the movie. Even today in my 40s, I love a good scary movie, even though I'm 100% not walking through my dark house after a movie is over.

A former student of mine came up to me a few years ago after their first (second? I don't know, it's all blending together) year in college suggesting that I look at the script for the play that you're about to see. Somewhere in the 9 years that I've been directing the fall production, I've developed a "type" of play that I like to direct, according to my students.

I hate when they're right.

When I started to read *Trap* a little more than a year ago, I instantly was hooked. I can't go much more into why, but I love when a script gets me excited and brainstorming from stage one.

The product of that excitement from all sides of this program is what you're about to enjoy. It's a show that will push you, challenge you, confuse you, and hopefully will stick with you long after you leave your seat in about 75-90 minutes.

The Thespian Scholarship in Memory of Stephanie Trotter was created to honor the memory of a fellow Thespian and Bolingbrook High School Graduate.


Each year, two scholarships are awarded in her memory to graduating Thespian members most in need of financial assistance for college. Preference is given to those also pursuing a career in theatre.






